- Broadens the curriculum through the utilization of may community resources
- Fosters and recognizes individual differences in interests and abilities of students
- Establishes a cooperative working relationship between the school and the community
- Demonstrates the concept that education is a community wide partnership where many stakeholders have an active role
- Enhances the public relations between the school community and the business community

Advantages to the Community and Businesses

- Provides the opportunity to develop good community-school relationships
- Allows site supervisors to share their expertise and serve as positive role models for young adults
- Brings recognition to the community for partnering with a school
