All employees of the **Canton Public Schools** are designated as **mandated reporters** under Massachusetts Law Chapter 119, sections 51A-E. "State law requires professionals whose work brings them in contact with children to notify the Department of Children & Families (DCF) if they suspect that a child has been – or is at risk of being – abused or neglected." Following are the steps one should take when you suspect that a child has been abused or neglected:

- If there is reasonable cause to believe that a child is suffering physical or emotional injury, the mandated reporter is to notify immediately the building principal or designated agent at the school.
- You are required to immediately report suspected abuse or neglect to the Department of Children and Families in either two ways:
  - Call the Intake Office at the Arlington DCF Office at 781-641-8500 and make a verbal report. Be sure to have the student's biographical information including address, telephone number and parent names. You must be specific with regard to the suspected abuse or neglect.
  - 2. Call the State Wide Child-At-Risk Hotline at **800-792-5200**.
- Within 48 hours of filing a verbal report, you must file a written report on the required DCF form. Always keep a copy for your records. Fax the completed DCF form to FAX # (781) 646-5172. Reporters must retain a fax receipt of the transmission for their record.

• The building principal must send a copy of the DCF Child Abuse written report to the Director of Student Services immediately.
