TRANSPORTATION POLICY

2009/2010 SCHOOL YEAR

STUDENTS ELIGIBLE FOR TRANSPORTATION (YELLOW FORM)

For the 2009/2010 school year, the Canton Public Schools has adopted the following policy for busing:

- Students in grades 1-12 who live more than one mile from the school they attend are transported.
- All kindergarten students regardless of distance are transported
- All students in grades 1-12 who must walk on or cross State Highway Route 138 (safely), are transported.

STUDENTS IN GRADES 1-12 WHI LIVE ONE MILE OR LESS FROM SCHOOL (GREEN FORM)

Students can apply for a bus pass on a seat available basis. Names of students who have secured a seat on the bus will be posted at each school on May 15th, 2009.
