**BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:**

An FY20 CCPC application was approved to fill cracks and resurface the two courts at the Galvin Middle School. After review of the site and project it was determined the courts are in poor condition and the specifications in the previous application would only provide a short 2-3 year fix of the courts. This proposal includes the procurement and installation of a tile system including basketball lines, and four regulation size poles, hoops, and rims.

**Summarize how the proposed project will benefit the Town of Canton and meet the goals of the Community Preservation Act:**

The outdoor basketball courts at Galvin Middle School have been in a state of disrepair for several years. As a result of the poor condition, court use is low. The courts are one of two sets of public basketball courts in the town. The other basketball courts are at the John F. Kennedy Elementary School and are used heavily by both the residents of Canton and the John F. Kennedy Elementary School. Refinishing the William H. Galvin Middle School Outdoor Basketball Courts will provide the residents of Canton a second option for outdoor basketball play. Also, bringing the courts online would give the William H. Galvin Middle School an option to expand its wellness programming.
