The Stoughton Summer School - High School Program offers students the opportunity to earn credit towards graduation requirements and to continue in sequential courses.

Students enrolling for academic credit must have previously taken the course and have passed at least two terms to qualify for summer school. Tuition is \$225 per course.

Students not currently attending the Stoughton Public Schools must provide their school's name, address and telephone number, as well as a transcript that verifies successful completion of at least two terms of the course in which the student wishes to be enrolled. It is the student's responsibility to verify credit acceptance upon completion of a summer school course.

High School Classes will be held from 8:00 AM to 10 AM.

Depending on what class a student signs up for, classes will be meet on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays or on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays.

Mondays -Thursdays: Classes will be held at Stoughton Public Library at 84 Park Street, Stoughton Ma. Fridays: Classes will be held at the O'Donnell Middle School at 211 Cushing Street, Stoughton, Ma.

Tuition: Tuition is \$225 per course. There will be no refunds once classes have begun.

Dates of Attendance: Stoughton Summer School will begin on Monday, July 8th and conclude Friday, August 2nd. Classes are held Monday through Friday 8:00 AM to 10:00 AM. Depending on what class a student signs up for a student will be in class on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays or on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays. All classes held Monday – Thursday are located at the Stoughton Public Library and on all classes held on Fridays are located at the O'Donnell Middle School.

Credit Eligibility: Students who have failed a full year course and have passed at least two terms are eligible for Summer School credit. Students who have failed a one-semester course and have passed at least one term are eligible for summer school credit. A withdrawal from any course during the academic year will disqualify the student from earning credit in summer school. Students who have lost credit due to excessive absences are reminded that they must complete the four-week Summer School program, meet the Stoughton Summer School attendance requirements, and pass the course in order to receive credit. Students will not receive credit if conduct in Summer School is inappropriate. There will be no refund if credit is denied.

Registration & Payment: Registration is open to students in grades 9-12. Students may register by mail by completing the application below and enclosing payment in the form of a money order payable to Stoughton Summer School. Tuition must be paid in full at the time of registration. Registrations will not be accepted after the first day of class.

Summer School Policy: A student may attend Stoughton Summer School to fulfill graduation requirements or to raise a grade in order to continue in a sequential course.

Registration Confirmation: Students will be notified if a course is cancelled due to insufficient enrollment or if a class is full and registrations are no longer being accepted. Confirmations will not be sent.
