Superintendent Summative Review Workshop *July 7, 2022*

The workshop began at 5:02 p.m.

Chair Merenda outlined that the workshop's goal was to serve as an overview of the process of presenting Superintendent Derek Folan's summative review to the community. She informed the committee that CPS teachers and administrators are evaluated using the same process, so the School Committee's evaluation of Superintendent Folan was aligned with other CPS evaluation tools.

Chair Merenda indicated that the summative review would be both a "backward-looking" document because it reviewed Superintendent Folan's performance during the 2021-2022 school year, as well as "forward-looking" as it offered Superintendent Folan the School Committee's perspective on areas of potential focus in the upcoming school year.

Superintendent Folan joined the workshop at 6 p.m.

Chair Merenda informed the committee that Superintendent Folan would share the summative review and supporting documents, including "Indicative Guidance for 2022-2023 Planning," at the July Cabinet retreat. She also said that TLA, a strategic planning group, would be working with Superintendent Folan and central office staff to develop a five-year strategic plan.
