 - b. Conduct quarterly checks of the K-12 Math curriculum implementation process and report on learning and impact on students, staff and families.
 - c. Support Principals in using the data to drive collaborative discussions, differentiate instruction and supports, and target designated standards for growth

 - e. Monitor screening data and formative data quarterly to assess progress in growth and learning.
 - f. Engage families and students with webinars and in-person sessions to review the implementation of the math curriculum.
